Items for Personal Use

7 x College Ruled Composition Books

Choose books with stitched spines, with cardboard (not poly) covers. Choose a variety of different colored (or picture) covers or personalize your books

1 x small Sketch diary (9 inch by 6 inch)

2 x packages of (4 squares per inch) graph filler paper
(At least 80 pages each)

1 x ruler (cm and inches)

3 x 2 pocket poly folders (1 yellow, 2 red)

1 x 1 inch 3 ring binder

2 x 5 tab dividers

1 x ½ inch heavy duty binder

2 x boxes (12 count) Ticonderoga pencils

4 x Red Pens

4 x Blue Pens

6 x fine point dry erase markers

1 x manual pencil sharpener

4 x erasers

12 x large glue sticks

1 x 4 pack of different colored highlighters

1 box of (at least 20) count - fine tip colored markers

1 box of (at least) 24 count colored pencils

1 x 2B, 4B and 6B pencils or a sketching/shading pencil kit

1 box of (at least) 24 count colored crayons (non-twistable). (Do not purchase washable crayons)

1 pair of scissors

1 x pencil pouch or box to keep your supplies in

1 x headphones or earbuds

1 x reusable water bottle for classroom use

1 Art shirt – An old long sleeved shirt, or an men's shirt (to be worn during messy art sessions). Thrift stores are a good source of shirts for this purpose if you have nothing at home.

1 Exercise Mat with carrying strap – for outdoor learning lessons, and lunchtime use

For personal use at desks

2 x Kleenex boxes

2 x large container of Clorox wipes

1 x box of gallon size Ziploc bags

1 x pump pack hand sanitizer

NAMING SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Please name ALL school supplies except for the books and binders. Each pen, pencil or crayon must be named separately. Pencils can be named by scraping the paint back and writing on the wood, writing on with permanent marker or using a label.
